



## Ordinance 22 - 11

### An Ordinance Amending Chapter 30, Section 30-803 , Animals of the City of Elk River, Minnesota, City Code

The City Council of the City of Elk River does hereby ordain as follows:

**SECTION 1.** That ~~§ Section 30-803~~ , Animals of the City of Elk River Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

(1) Number and type of chickens.

- a. A maximum of 12 chickens (hens) are allowed on parcels two and one-half to five acres on all residentially zoned properties.
- b. For all residentially zoned properties, larger than five acres, the number of chickens shall be as outlined in Section 30-803 (e)(2).
- c. For parcels within the R-1a zoning district, the number of chickens can be increased with a conditional use permit, as described in this section.
- d. Chickens are not permitted on parcels below two and one-half acres in size in the R1-b, R1-c, and R1-d zoning district.
- e. Roosters are not permitted on parcels two and one-half acres to five acres in size, unless a conditional use permit is granted on parcels within the R-1a zoning district only.

**SECTION 2.** That this ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and be published as provided by law.
