## Eligibility Requirements for items to be accepted:

- **Tires** additional charge for rims
- **Mixed Junk** does not include electronics, appliances, tires or other charged-for items
- **Liquids** and **Fluids** must be drained from all items
- **Load** your vehicle with batteries, bulbs and electronics available for removal first
- **Load** your vehicle with tires, mixed junk, mattresses and furniture to be removed last
- **Plan to unload your own items**
- **Items not listed** on the form must be approved prior to delivery, call with questions
- Your **form** will be reviewed by gate staff. **Your total is subject to change**

Curbside recyclables

Construction and Demolition Debris

Oil, Oil Containers (can take to Compost Site)

Pesticides/Herbicides/Insecticides

Paint/Stains/Solvents

Hazardous or Medical Waste

Commercial/Business accounts
